

# Stages Bloomington COVID-19 Safety Policy for Seussical, JR

Updated 01/10/2022

Keeping our students, their families, and our artistic staff safe is our highest priority. By following CDC protocols and even exceeding those expectations allows Stages Bloomington to continue our programming.

## Vaccine Requirements:

- Student participants must show proof of vaccination by the first day of rehearsal, February 7, 2022. Instructors and staff are also required to have been fully vaccinated.
- There will be no exceptions to our vaccination requirement for participants.

## Safety Practices:

- Masks will be required except when eating or drinking.
  - Students will be asked to provide their own masks but Stages will have disposable masks available.
- Health screening for symptoms of COVID-19
  - Parents will be asked to take participants' temperatures before each class. If a participant's temperature is above 100.0 degrees we ask that the student remain home that day.
  - Self-report/evaluation checklist of symptoms before each class:
    - Temperature above 100.4 or chills
    - Sore Throat or shortness of breath
    - Diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting, abdominal pain
    - Headache, particularly new onset of severe headache, especially with fever
    - New loss of taste or smell
- All restrooms will be sanitized prior to class, following bathroom breaks and at the end of each day.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout the rehearsal space.
- Students will be asked to bring their own water bottles.

Stages Bloomington Company is not responsible for the possible transmission of Covid from staff, instructors, or other students. Any updates to Covid guidelines will be sent to families.
